

Great Allegheny Bike Ride

October 18, Saturday – 10:30 am

Location: Great Allegheny Passage – Meyersdale to Big Savage Tunnel

Come and join us for a late autumn ride on the Great Allegheny Passage. We will ride from Meyersdale, PA, through the recently opened Big Savage Tunnel (3,294 Ft. long) to the state line. This is a 22 round trip ride that includes the highest point on the entire trail at 2,392 ft.. For the adventurous set, Frostburg MD is only another 5 miles from the state line. You may turn around at the tunnel or continue to Frostburg

Directions: Turnpike, Somerset Exit #110, proceed through 3 traffic lights and at the 4th, turn LEFT onto E Main Street. At the next light, bear RIGHT onto Berlin Plank Road. (becomes Rt. 219 S). Go 3 miles then turn RIGHT onto Garrett Shortcut Road. Continue 8 miles to a stop sign and turn LEFT onto Rt. 653. Proceed slowly through Garrett and turn RIGHT onto business 219 S. Go on 219 S about 2 miles. Then turn RIGHT onto Business 219. Once in town, turn left onto Main Street by the fire station. Proceed 4 blocks up the hill and across the tracks to the station on your left. Be at the trail head at 10:30 am
