

## FALL BIKING

Come and join us for a late autumn ride on the Great Allegheny Passage. We will ride from Meyersdale, PA through the Big Savage Tunnel (3,294 ft. long) to the state line. You will be amazed at the wondrous views as you exit the tunnel. This is an 18 mile round trip ride and includes the highest point on the trail, 2,392 ft. For those who want more miles, Frostburg MD is only another 8 miles from the tunnel. You can either have lunch in Frostburg or back in Meyersdale.

**Directions:** Turnpike, Somerset exit #110. Proceed through 3 traffic lights and at the 4th, turn left onto East Main Street. At the next light, bear right onto Berlin Plank Road (becomes Route 219 S). Go 3 miles then turn right onto Garrett Shortcut Road. Continue 8 miles to a stop sign and turn left onto Route 653. Proceed slowly through Garrett and turn right onto Route 219 S. Go on Route 219 S about 2 miles, then turn right onto Business 219. Once in the town of Meyersdale, turn left onto Main Street by the fire station. Proceed 4 blocks up the hill, and across the tracks you will see the train station on your left.
