Did you know the South Side Slopes have 68 public stairways, with over 5,000 steps? We can't climb them all in one day, but we'll hit a lot! Houses cling to hillsides, churches rise from below. Watch your step as we zig and zag for a few miles through Pittsburgh's steepest neighborhood. Half way through the walk will be a stop for a liquid refreshment and potty break at Nowicki's Bar on Mission Street.

Directions: East Carson Street (Rte. 837) to 21st Street. Turn onto 21st Street away from the river. Proceed 7 streets to the intersection of Josephine Street
