Directions:

From the North: Take 79 south to 279 south exiting at the Camp Horne Road exit. Turn right at the exit. Go through 3 traffic lights and around a sharp bend. The park will be approximately 1/4 mile on the left.

From the South: Take 579 North to 279 North exiting at the Camp Horne Road exit. Turn left at the exit. Go through 3 traffic lights and around a sharp bend. The park will be approximately 1/4 mile on the left.

From the East: Take 376 West to 579 North to 279 North exiting at the Camp Horne Road exit. Turn left at the exit. Go through 3 traffic lights and around a sharp bend. The park will be approximately 1/4 mile on the left.

From the West: Take Route 60 South to 79 North exiting at the Emsworth exit. Ramp will put you onto Ohio River Blvd. Go straight on Ohio River Blvd. to the 3rd traffic light. Turn left at the light onto Camp Horne Road. Follow Camp Horne Road for approximately 2 miles; the park will be on the right.
