*Geocaching is a hobby that uses a GPS to find items (containers) hidden in the woods – like a scavenger hunt.*

Join Janet Ball on a geocaching hike along the Montour Trail in Cecil PA. Janet will explain the concept of geocaching – a hobby which uses GPS coordinates to find a hidden (cached) treasure. Janet has been an avid geocacher since 2009 and has found close to 3000 caches. The portion of the trail we will be hiking and exploring is in Hendersonville off Morganza Road. There is a series of geocaches hidden along and just off the trail. We will be hiking approximately 2 miles round trip and hopefully finding about 10 geocaches of different sizes and difficulty. We will be parking in a lot on Cecil Henderson Road. Janet will meet everyone at the old King's Restaurant in Bridgeville at 8:45 am and everyone can caravan to the parking area. The hike will be a **“green circle”** (●) difficulty rating with an occasional off-trail challenge to access the site of the hidden cache. Remember to dress for the weather and bring water and snacks. The event is open to all members and friends. Please email to **RSVP** or if you have questions. **A GPS is not necessary for this hike.**

#### **Directions to Meeting Point (Old King's Restaurant):**

From **I-79**, take **exit 54** (Bridgeville). At the end of the ramp, turn **right** onto **Millers Run Road (route 50) toward Bridgeville**. Go approximately **¼ miles** to the traffic light at **Washington Pike**. Turn **right** onto **Washington Pike**. Go approximately **¼ miles** then turn **left** onto **Daniell Drive**. In **200 feet** make a **right** into King's parking lot.

#### **Directions to Montour Trail Parking Area:**

From **I-79**, take **exit 48** (Southpointe). At the end of the ramp, turn **east** (uphill) towards Hendersonville and go **½ miles** to the stop sign at **Morganza Road**. Turn **left** onto **Morganza Road**, and then go **0.6 miles** downhill and turn **left** onto **Cecil Henderson Road**. Travel **1.2 miles** on **Cecil Henderson Road** to the trail access/parking area on the **left** directly **across from Caley Lane**.
