A quick history on The TAMBURITZANS: The Tamburitzans were created in 1937 by Dr. A. Lester Pierce, who brought his "Slavonic Tamburitzza Orchestra" from St. Edward's University of Austin, Texas to Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, where the group was well received by the region's diverse ethnic communities. Dr. Pierce negotiated an arrangement with Duquesne University, involving a work scholarship program, and the tradition of The Tamburitzans began. Over the years, The Tamburitzans have recorded albums and have toured extensively (sometimes internationally) performing music and dance mainly from Eastern Europe and its neighboring folk cultures.

Directions:

Follow PA-88 South (Library Rd) to Corrigan Dr in Bethel Park (approximately 4.8 miles from Rt-51 or 2.8 miles from Castle Shannon Blvd). Make a slight left through the traffic light onto Corrigan Dr and go approximately 1.1 miles to a traffic circle. At the traffic circle, take the second exit and stay on Corrigan Dr. Go approximately 1.2 miles more to Brownsville Rd. Turn right onto Brownsville Rd and go approximately 0.2 miles. Turn left onto Farmshow Rd. Parking will be on your right. The amphitheater is behind the parking area toward McCorkle Rd.
