Sign-up Deadline: August 18, 2008. The limit was just extended to 100 PSC members. This trip always sells out very quickly, so sign up today.

Join your PSC friends for one of our most successful trips. If you are a golfer, beacher, shopper, or just want to s-t-r-e-t-c-h out your summer, this trip is for you. As usual, we'll be right on the beach in the Sands Resorts. This year you will have the option of a regular oceanfront hotel room, a one-bedroom oceanfront junior suite, or a three-bedroom ocean view executive suite. The hotel room and junior suite are two per room and the executive suite is four per suite. The executive suites have three bedrooms with two beds per bedroom, two bathrooms, a combined living and dining area, a full kitchen and a balcony. They come with a washer and dryer. They are in the building behind the Oceanside building. The hotel room is just a standard hotel room with two beds and a balcony. The junior suites have a bedroom with two beds, a small living and dining area, a kitchenette and a balcony.

LODGING OPTIONS WILL BE FIRST COME FIRST SERVED

The sooner you sign up, the more time we have to provide the lodging option that you request. All persons in your unit must arrive and depart on the same day. NO EXCEPTIONS. The resort has hot tubs, indoor and outdoor pools, a lazy river, a water park, restaurants, a bar and, of course, the beach and ocean plus all the attractions of Myrtle Beach. The trip will include a cocktail reception on Sunday evening, a full breakfast every morning and a group dinner at one of the local restaurants. I will also try and arrange a complimentary dinner at the hotel restaurant, but that may not materialize. And, of course, everyone on the trip will receive a traditional souvenir memento.
